ш A few of our most significant achievements this year include:


- 1. We have served over 14,000 Students in Northwest Ohio with the optimal health message of sexual risk avoidance in 119 locations for 2024!
- 2. Tyro Support Services completed 9th season of TYRO TV a twice monthly Healthy Relationship television program with educational and motivational content to inspire viewers to develop healthy, thriving families that is distributed nationally to 80% of all prison populations nationally via tablets with over one million downloads!
- 3. Enhanced partnership with Franklin County CBCF in Columbus adding additional forklift/OSHA training, Father/Child TYRO Families Training in addition to our healthy marriage and relationship preparation programming, and The RIDGE Project has its own unit for classroom and offices to teach TYRO 5 days per week.
- 4. Offering Industrial Electrical and Welding training, pre-release, through mobile training units and instructors provided by our partner, Northwest State Community College to over 40 men and women so far in 2025!
- 5. Launched our new TYRO Families program. This program brings incarcerated fathers who are TYROs together with their children for 8 sessions of TYRO Youth. The children of incarcerated fathers learn how to practice resiliency, build healthy relationships, and understand the success sequence to achieve their goals and dreams.

Your generosity and dedication have truly made a difference, and we are blessed to have you as part of our RIDGE Family. As we look to the future with optimism and hope, we know that there will be new challenges and new opportunities ahead. We are committed to staying true to our mission, and to adapting and evolving our programs and services to meet the ever-changing needs of youth and fragile families. THE RIDGE PROJECT, HOME OF TYRO

25 Years of service to Ohio Families

Served adults in 28 prisons and facilities throughout the state of OHIO

Over 35,000 adults received TYRO programming 1,673 of those were in served in 2024

THE POWER OF TYRO – A TYRO'S STORY

One of the most powerful examples of the impact of your support comes from a participant in our Tyro Couples Program at the Ohio Reformatory for Women (ORW). Let me introduce Lazennia, a young woman that sent us a letter after she had been released. She took everything very seriously while taking TYRO Couples inside the facility and was determined to succeed. She had been in a transitional house after release and took some manufacturing training. Shortly after graduating from the training, she was blessed with 4 interviews in one day, but was concerned how her past might impact those interviews. She reached out to her case manager and talked over the different things she learned; fear, facing everything, recovery, and stepping out knowing your worth. She called back later to let her case manager know that ALL 4 employers were interested in her. She said they didn't seem bothered at all by her past, like they didn't see it. One told her that something about her 'shines'.

She's a woman of faith and gave credit to God. She is thankful for being a part of The RIDGE through TYRO. Her personal message to others - "The Ridge Project and becoming a TYRO has been such a blessing to my life. I pray that everyone that becomes a part of this organization appreciates the things that are done through this program because it's done with love & pure heart."

83 participants enrolled and served in two of the highest security prisons in Ohio - Toledo Correctional and Ohio State Penitentiary


175 participants enrolled in our Keeping Faith program across 6 facilities

Thank you, ODRC for your partnership with The RIDGE Project, Home of TYRO. We are rehabilitating, reinventing, and reestablishing!

In 2024, we taught TYRO in 17 of the 28 prisons in the state of Ohio. From 2016 to present, we have serviced TYRO programing in 40 facilities, including CBCF's.

The RIDGE Project has been awarded 32 different state/federal grants from state, federal and philanthropic funding sources, and counting!

Grafton Correctional - 2024

Throughout 2024, TYRO Talks at Grafton Correctional Institution consistently engaged approximately 150 participants per session. These impactful sessions featured powerful speakers, including Ron Tijerina, Jim Tabler, and Brandon Tijerina, who shared messages of transformation, leadership, and personal growth.

Ron Tijerina, co-founder of TYRO, inspired attendees with his journey of resilience and redemption, emphasizing the importance of taking ownership of one's future. Jim Tabler provided practical insights on leadership and decision-making, empowering individuals to break cycles of incarceration. Brandon Tijerina brought a fresh perspective, motivating participants with stories of overcoming adversity and building a legacy of change.

Each TYRO Talk fostered an environment of encouragement, self-reflection, and personal development, equipping attendees with tools to redefine their identities and prepare for successful reintegration into society.

TYRO Talks at Richland Correctional - 2024

In 2024, TYRO Talks at Richland Correctional Institution provided an impactful platform for personal growth and transformation, with approximately 50 participants attending each session. The speaker lineup featured Daniel Williams, Ron Tijerina, Tim Snoke, Michael Parker, and Jim Tabler, each bringing valuable insights on leadership, accountability, and overcoming adversity.

Ron Tijerina shared his powerful journey of redemption, encouraging attendees to take control of their futures. Daniel Williams and Tim Snoke provided guidance on resilience and breaking negative cycles, while Michael Parker inspired participants with messages of perseverance and self-improvement. Jim Tabler offered practical strategies for leadership and decision-making, equipping individuals with tools to create lasting change.

These sessions fostered an environment of encouragement, self-reflection, and empowerment, helping participants develop the mindset and skills needed to rebuild their lives and prepare for a successful future.

TYRO ENTREPRENEURSHIP PROGRAM


The RIDGE Project recently completed its first TYRO Entrepreneurship Program (TEP) at the Richland Correctional Institution. The TEP was funded by the Frameworks grant. Through this program delivery, 22 men received entrepreneurship training over a six-month period.

Throughout the training, many of the men made actual plans to begin their re-entry journey with a focus on starting a small business as either a complement or an alternative to their goals for post-release employment.

The program culminated in a Pitch Night Event on March 12th, 2024. During the event, four men pitched their business concept to four entrepreneur judges. The judges were all successful businesspeople from around the state. Financial awards for the participants came from private funding. The judges awarded a prize for Best Business Presentation and a prize for Best Business Concept. The financial awards ranged from \$500 to \$1500. All four participants received at least the minimum award for their participation.

All of the participants will receive their funds and additional business startup support over the next year from Case Managers and collaborative partners located in the various communities where the participants live. This year's finalists came from locations as diverse as Cleveland, Canton, and Toledo, Ohio.





PEER FACILITATED DELIVERY

Peer Facilitated Delivery supported with professional Case Management at Richland Correctional, Grafton Correctional and North Central. Peer facilitated classes expand our reach and provide services to individuals that don't qualify for grant funded delivery.

In these prisons, we have:

- Richland 8 Peer facilitators
- North Central 9 Peer facilitators
- Grafton Correctional 9 Peer facilitators

FAITH BASED CONTRACT

TYRO Keeping FAITH Contract features the TYRO Man of God (MOG) curriculum. TYRO MOG focuses on Biblical principles that encourage an ever-increasing faith in God and a like-minded community that provides celebration and accountability. TYRO Keeping FAITH is currently serving six different ODRC prisons, helping men become the Men of God they were designed to be. TYRO Keeping FAITH program has five key components. First, participants will take our tenweek TYRO class that is steeped in Christian values and Biblical principles designed to deepen your faith in God as participants explore their purpose and the love God poured into creating us intentionally for this time. Next, program completers participate in our TYRO Accountability Community (TAC). TAC is a small-group format designed to provide support, encouragement, resources, and accountability while inside. Once released, TAC connections are made to TYROS from around the country who continue their journey as men and women worth following. Third, participants will underpin the value of family by participating in family events approved by the institution. Fourth, we will offer CORE/Couple Communication, a four-week class that empowers TYROS to communicate effectively and efficiently in every area of their lives. Lastly, after completing TYRO Keeping FAITH participants will have at their disposal a myriad of aftercare services, including, but not limited to, intentional referrals, case management, mentoring, networking, job referrals, and community connections. THIS PROGRAM IS DESIGNED FOR ALL TO PARTICIPATE AND EXPERIENCE PERSONAL AND PROFESSIONAL GROWTH. EVERYONE IS WELCOME, REGARDLESS OF FAITH, RELIGION, RACE, GENDER, OR SECURITY STATUS.

NEW FATHER AND CHILD OPPORTUNITIES

We are excited to begin a new project. We will be working with incarcerated fathers and their children at Grafton Correctional. The youth will have the opportunity to meet with their incarcerated parent and walk through the TYRO youth curriculum.

The goal of this project is multifaceted. We want to engage youth in a positive youth development program, as well as encourage parent participation. For these fathers, it will be an opportunity to "parent" their children, creating strong relationships despite the barrier of incarceration.




TEACHING ETHICS TO OUR YOUTH

YOUTH DIVISION FILM CAMPS

As a sophomore in high school, Ethan Fritz never imagined that a single trip to Washington, DC, would ignite a lifelong passion for public service. A proud member of the Ohio Youth Congress (OYC), Ethan had always been interested in civic engagement, but it was his experience walking the halls of the nation's capital and speaking with local legislators that transformed his interest into a calling. During his visit, Ethan had the opportunity to sit across from lawmakers, ask tough questions, and witness firsthand how policy decisions impact communities back home. Because of this opportunity provided by The RIDGE Project's Youth Department, Ethan realized the power of informed leadership and the responsibility that comes with public service.

That trip to DC planted a seed that only grew stronger with time. Inspired by the experience, Ethan set his sights on studying political science, determined to bridge the gap between young voices and policymakers. Now a second-year student at Miami University in Oxford, Ohio, he is living out that mission, pursuing his degree while interning in the office of Congressman Jim Jordan in Washington, DC.

From a passionate high school student to a future leader in public policy, Ethan's journey is just beginning. But one thing is certain—his commitment to service and his belief in the power of civic engagement will continue to shape his path, proving that a single experience can change everything.


Spent on Management and Administration (that's 6.1% of what we spent on Adult and youth services)
